- The organization and execution of internationalizing projects and events, as well as information events for students, lecturers and staff, such as summer schools, staff weeks, orientation days and the annual study abroad fair
- The coordination of international networks (such as Ge4, CEEPUS, ASEA-UNINET and EPU)
- The administration and maintenance of international cooperation, contracts and agreements between MUL and other universities and institutions

INFORMATION ⇔ ORGANIZATION ⇔ SUPPORT

INCOMING students & staff: Students, researchers and staff from a foreign university/ institution, who attend MUL as their guest university for a certain period of time (max. 12 months). They are also called guest or exchange students, guest researchers, guest lecturers and guest staff.

OUTGOING students & staff: Students, researchers and staff of MUL who spend max. 12 months at a foreign partner university/ institution.
